How To Use

Print this page on cardstock. Fold in half & staple or tape the sides together to make a Pocket.

Cut all the Sequence, Blank, and Answer Cards. Place them inside this Storage Pocket.

If you have organized the Cards into Beginning, Middle & Ending, take out one of the piles and put them into the Sequence following the story as it happened in the characters' lives.

Do the same with the other piles until you have the whole story. Add your other pieces of information into the Sequence.

FEETSPEAK SEQUENCE CARDS

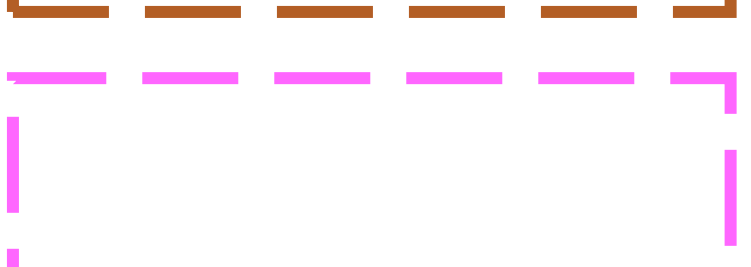
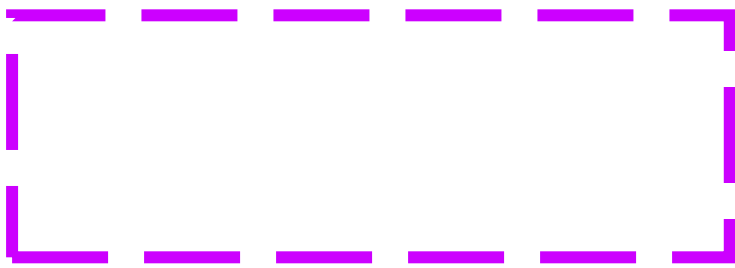
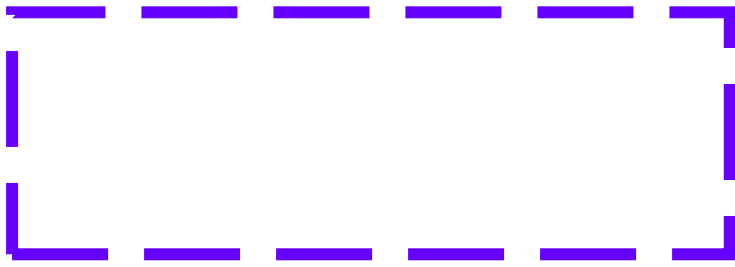
