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INTRODUCTION

There are many interesting characters in the Story of FEETSPEAK who influence the story 's plot in many important ways.

I created this Activity to help you explore and navigate the different characters with their traits and how they influence the story

Several of the characters experience life-altering changes because of their Traits as well as the Traits of other characters.

There are numerous clues throughout the story supporting the huge variety of Character Traits.

Remember ~ a Character's Emotions are NOT the same as a Character's Traits. Emotions can change very quickly, like sad into happy. However, Traits develop and may change over a period of time, like transforming bad behaviors into good ones.

CONSTRUCTION INSTRUCTIONS

MATERIALS NEEDED: card-stock, printing paper, bindings (stapler, coil/ comb, O-ring/hole-punch), pencil, colors

SEQUENCE: You can print the <u>Front/Back Covers</u> on card-stock and the other pages on printing paper, making a <u>Master Copy</u> of all the Activities. Bind the <u>Booklet</u> together for easy access.

You can make multiple, double-sided copies on printing paper of: the <u>Character Traits Organizer, Map, Character's Development</u>, & the <u>Spotlight</u> templates, depending on how many Character Profiles you will be doing.

Double-side copy the reference sheets: both <u>Who Am I</u> pages, <u>Character</u> <u>Traits List w/ the Table</u>, & the <u>Map Diagram w/ the Development Diagram</u>.

The <u>Character Chronicles</u> covers can be copied on card-stock with the completed <u>Spotlight</u> pages inserted and bound together as a "periodical".

You can, also, laminate all of the Fill-In templates and re-use them, except for the Spotlight sheets, which you will copy on printing paper to include in the <u>Character Chronicles period</u>ical collection.


ACTIVITY PLAN

You can select Characters from the <u>Who Am I ?</u> activity or other Characters from the story of FEETSPEAK.



You don't need to copy the illustrations from the book~ use your imagination from the descriptive language in the text to create your own images of the Characters you are including.



WHO AM I ? : Match the Image with the Character's Name



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




Use the Image Symbols above to help you create a Character Profile for each person or couple. Think about how each Character was important to the plot of the Story.





 - · predictions for what will happen next in the character's life


