
# Themes & Threads



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### INTRODUCTION

The Theme of a story is the main message you, as the reader, learn about the main character. It is the writer's thoughts and views s/he wants to share about the world and/or human nature.

It is NOT the story's Main Idea, the plot, or the conflict.

A story can have several Themes that are interwoven with Threads affecting its other characters, a variety of conflicts, problems, and their solutions. How the main character in FEETSPEAK ~ Cinnamon~ faces her challenges throughout the story is its PRIMARY theme:

- What are her actions during a variety of situations?
  - How does Cinnamon communicate?
- · What specific things are associated with Cinnamon?
- What are some facts about her, such as her physical appearance?
  - What do other characters say about Cinnamon?
    - How do they react to her?
  - Does Cinnamon change in the story? How? Why?

FEETSPEAK'S story contains several Themes interwoven with many different Threads, such as family, friendship, Nature, compassion, and perseverance.

### CONSTRUCTION INSTRUCTIONS

MATERIALS: cardstock, printing paper, heavy tape and/or stapler, scissors (plain or decorative), rubber bands or clips, post-its, pencil, glue stick, poster board, colored & decorative papers, hole punch, yarns/ribbons/string

SEQUENCE: Copy on cardstock: <u>Storage Pocket</u>, <u>Vocabulary & their Synonym</u> <u>Cards</u>, <u>Story Quilt Square Templates</u>, and the <u>Story Quilt Square Diagram</u>.

Fold & crease Storage Pocket. Tape and/or staple the open, parallel sides together, forming the pocket.

Cut out & group together with rubber bands or clips: the <u>Vocabulary Words</u>, their <u>Synonyms</u>, and the <u>Quilt Square Template</u> pieces. Cut out the <u>Diagram</u> with its arrows, folding the arrows to the image. Place everything in the <u>Pocket.</u>

If you decide to use some or all of the <u>Story Quilt Square Samples</u>, copy them on printing paper. Cut them out, using straight-edged or decorative-edged scissors. Then, clip them together and place them in the <u>Storage Pocket</u> until you're ready to use them for your Story Quilt.

Use the <u>Templates</u> to trace & cut out the pieces you will need for labeling the Squares and writing your text-support sentences.

### ACTIVITY PLAN

Play the Match Game with the Themes & Threads Vocabulary/Synonyms to help you decide what kind of Quilt you want to make.

Use the post-its to mark where in the story you locate the text-support for your Theme/Thread Quilt Squares. Be sure to label them with the correct Theme and/or Thread idea.

There are several ways you can create your FEETSPEAK Story Quilt:

### <u>Construction</u>

- Glue completed paper Squares to a piece of poster board.
- Double-side the poster board for several Themes and/or Threads.
- · Print Squares on cardstock, hole-punch & use yarn to make the quilt.
  - Double-side the Squares for multiple Theme/Threads.
  - Use paper Squares to glue onto cut-out cardstock squares.

### Themes & Threads

- Choose a Theme with Squares that support it.
- Use similar colors/ patterns to express a Theme/Thread.
- · Make a Quilt about one character or one action sequence or setting.
  - · Select colors/patterns to reflect the mood or idea of the Square.
- Create several "mini" quilts (9 squares) & bind them together as a book.


# HOW TO PLAY
